A veteran police officer of 17 years, Ken has worked on a variety of important law enforcement assignments and he is committed to making sure our public schools remain safe and drug free. He was proud to serve as a "DARE officer" (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) in our nearby schools.

Ken is a well-known and well-respected critic of the current CUSD leadership. He played a key role in the original 2005 CUSD Recall campaign and has continued to support the on-going community campaign to restore honesty, integrity and accountability to the CUSD Board of Trustees and administration.

Ken received a reserve commission in the United States Army in 1984 and served with distinction until 1990. He rejoined the military after our country was attacked on 9-11.

Ken earned a B.S. in Communication Arts, a M.A. in Management and was a Senior Fellow at the UCLA School of Public Policy and Social Research.

Ken currently serves as the Director of Legislative Affairs for a member of the California State Board of Equalization.
